Forest Area School District
Schedule for Reopening

Green Phase/Low Risk of Transmission

In the green phase or when there is a low risk of transmission, students will have the option of attending school in-person or remotely. We will follow the approved calendar and students will attend a full day of classes either in-person or remotely. Below are brief descriptions of each of the options for students.

In-school learning

Students will be able to attend school in person. We will adhere to the Forest Area School District Comprehensive Health and Safety Plan which includes social distancing, the wearing of face coverings, changes in transportation and increased cleaning and sanitizing. However, the learning experience for students will remain the same with in-person instruction from their own classroom teachers.

Remote Learning

This option will look different than it did last spring. This model will provide students with a daily schedule of classes. Students will remain with their assigned teacher(s) and follow the same schedule of classes as if they were participating in-person. Students will be provided with a Chromebook to be used for joining real-time classes through Google Meet and will be able to interact with their teacher and their classmates. Attendance will be required and assignments, tests/quizzes will be graded just as they would if students were in their school. This option will lend itself to the most seamless transition from at-home learning to at-school learning should student(s) return to the school building.

Cyber Learning

Through this option students in K-12 will be enrolled in the district's online curriculum, hosted by Educere, an online learning vendor. This is a self-paced, self-guided option for students and is separate from traditional teacher-led instruction. This option is not facilitated by District teachers however, certified teachers are available to help students with class work. Students participating in cyber learning are eligible to participate in Forest Area athletics and extracurricular activities. Students that choose to participate in cyber learning are strongly encouraged to do so for at least one semester since it is difficult to transition mid-way through the course.

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Yellow Phase/Moderate Risk of Transmission

It is expected that based upon our numbers, that students can be safely accommodated in the building and maintain six foot social distancing during instruction so the same schedule as was presented in the Green Phase/Low Risk of Transmission will likely be followed. Parents may elect to have students participate via remote learning.

Red Phase/Substantial Risk of Transmission

Learning for elementary students will be in-person unless parents elect remote learning.

Learning for students in grades 7-12 will follow a hybrid model in which students will attend school in-person 2 days a week and remotely 3 days a week. Parents may elect 5 days of remote learning.
